

Christian	A Christian is a follower of Jesus Christ, believing He is God's Son, the Messiah, who came to save humanity, and whose life, death (crucifixion), and resurrection offer forgiveness and eternal life.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To know that different denominations of Christians worship and believe in God in different ways.
Denomination	A religious denomination is a distinct subgroup within a larger religion, sharing a common name, traditions, identity, and often an organizational structure.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To understand the importance of trends in data, that show long-term views of data.
Data	Facts and statistics that have been collected together to offer answers or analysis.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To know that anyone, around the world can be a Christian – it is not dependent on race or nationality.
Belief	Belief is the mental acceptance that something is true or exists, often without complete proof, representing a conviction, faith, or opinion.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - To understand that there is not one way to have 'belief' in God. Different people show belief in God in many different ways.
Survey	A survey is a structured method to collect information or opinions from a sample of people, often via a questionnaire, to understand a larger group's		



	attitudes, behaviours, or characteristics for research.

Christian worldviews	A Christian worldview is a thorough view, rooted in the Bible, that interprets all of life through the belief in a Creator God, the significance of Jesus Christ's redemption, and God's ultimate purpose for humanity and the world.
