## SCHOOL LUNCH PRICES

There is a price change for school hot lunches, which will be coming into effect on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> April. The price will increase to £2.85 per meal.

For every child that is entitled to free school meals, the school receives extra funding to enhance provision and improve progress and outcomes for children. So please apply even if you do not wish to take up your free school meal.

**Infant free school meals** - Your child will be able to get free school meals if they are in: Reception, Year 1 & Year 2. We still ask that you apply for free school meals to prevent the school missing out on additional funding.

## HOLIDAY FREE SCHOOL MEAL VOUCHER SCHEME

For February 2025 half term, Gloucestershire County Council will provide families in receipt of Free School Meals, who sign up to this offer, with vouchers to assist with food costs during the school holidays. Families who sign up to the scheme or who are already registered will receive a total of £15 per eligible child.

Voucher code emails will be sent from week commencing 10 February. If parents have not received their vouchers by 17 February, we encourage them to submit a query via the Microsoft Form [HERE](#). Families are to check their emails including junk/spam folders during this period, as sometimes the vouchers can go into those folders.

To ensure the scheme has reached all those who are eligible, parents that have not previously signed up, are being encouraged to do so, as soon as they can.

**Families not already registered** to receive holiday FSM vouchers can make an application from midday 27 January until midday on 7 February.

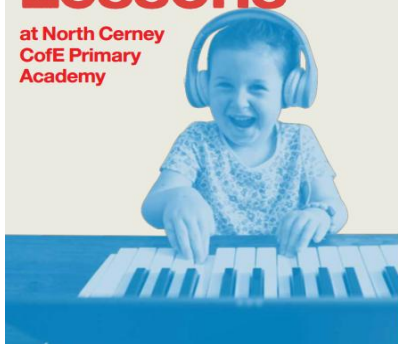
