Key Information that you should know by the end of the unit

- Christians believe that The Lost Son and the Lost sheep are parables from the Bible told by Jesus to teach people how they should care for others and how God cares for them with love and forgiveness. Christians use these stories to help guide them in how to support other people in their lives.
- All world religions have rules showing that followers should care for others.
- People without religion also believe that we should take care of one another and of the world using love and forgiveness.
- Many Christians believe there is a 'Big Story' in the Bible and that God is involved in creating the world.
