Subject Specific Vocabulary		Map of UK	Sticky Knowledge about local food production
fresh food	A food that has not been altered		<input type="checkbox"/> I know that I live in North Cerney, where there are few shops. My nearest town is Cirencester.
processed food	A food or ingredient that has been altered in some way eg by freezing, canning, baking, mixing with other ingredients. This is performed in a factory.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know that some of our food is produced in England and the UK but other foods need hotter and wetter climates to grow.
high street	The main street in a village, town or city which usually contains a mixture of shops		<input type="checkbox"/> I know that milk comes from cows and can discuss its journey from farm to supermarket.
warehouse	Food products are stored in a warehouse before being taken to shops		<input type="checkbox"/> I can name the 4 countries of the UK: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

grazing field	A field covered with grass that is suitable for grazing by animals.		
frozen food	Frozen food is preserved by a freezing process and stored in a freezer before cooking.		
Food producers or farmers	People who produce our food. They may plant crops and/ or raise animals to do this. The food they sell is called <b>produce</b> .
