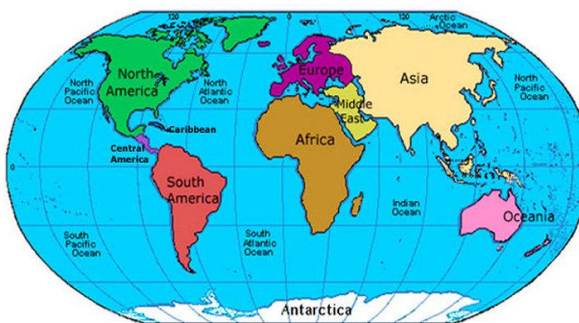
Key Vocabulary
