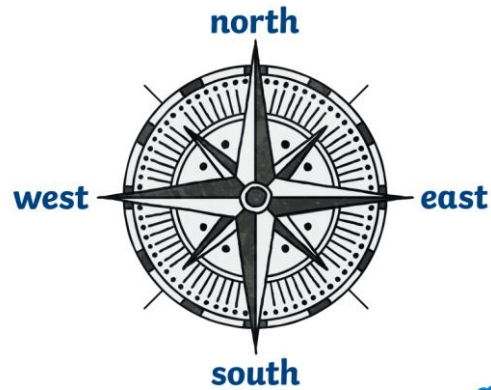

## Sticky Knowledge about maps and fieldwork

### Capital city

London is the capital city of the United Kingdom. A capital city is where the government of a country is based.

### United Kingdom

### map
