


<p>Shows their confidence and self-esteem through being outgoing towards people, taking risks and trying new things or new social situations and being able to express their needs and ask adults for help</p>	<p>Offer help with activities when asked but not before and see struggle and mistakes as important parts of learning.</p> <p>Provide experiences and activities that are challenging but achievable.</p>		
<p>Understands that expectations vary depending on different events, social situations and changes in routine, and becomes more able to adapt their behaviour in favourable conditions</p>	<p>Discuss rules and fairness with young children and show positive appreciation of young children's pro-social behaviours of kindness and helpfulness for example.</p>		
<p>Attempts to repair a relationship or situation where they have caused upset and understands how their actions impact other people</p>	<p>Offer environments that include stimulating and challenging spaces but also calm and comfortable spaces.</p>		
<p>Has a clear idea about what they want to do in their play and how they want to go about it</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shows confidence in choosing resources and perseverance in carrying out a chosen activity 	<p>Notice and appreciate young children's efforts not just their achievements, encouraging their inner motivation rather than working just for your approval or a sticker.</p>
